Executive Summary

Omega Consulting Group was appointed by the Swinburne Student Union (SSU) Council to administer its 2021 Annual Election, with Josh Gilligan, of Omega Consulting Group, appointed as Returning Officer for the Association.

The SSU Student Council resolved to conduct the 2021 Annual Election via postal ballot due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic preventing an attendance election and seeking to maximise student participation in the election.

Enclosed In this report Is a breakdown of all relevant stages in the election as well as recommendations for the 2021 SSU Election.

Ticket registration

In accordance with the Election Regulations and the timeline stipulated in the Notice of Election pertaining to student representative positions, a period for the registration and re-registration of tickets was opened on 2 August 2021. Two applications to re-register previous tickets were received and accepted in accordance with the Election Regulations.

Nominations

A total of 90 nominations for various positions were received and accepted. All nominations received satisfied the eligibility provisions in the Election Regulations and or the Constitution of the Association.

A small number of positions were uncontested with only one nomination with the majority of positions requiring a poll to be conducted. A full breakdown can be found in the appendices of this report.

Postal vote applications

By resolution of the Association, the ballot for all positions were conducted by post.

In order to participate in the election, members of the Association and students of the university completed a postal vote application, which was then submitted to the Returning Officer. Upon receipt, applications were assessed to ensure they complied with the Election Regulations and Constitution of the Association and the relevant ballot papers issued to those whose applications were accepted.

A total of 614 postal vote applications were lodged with the Returning Officer, with 597 being accepted. 17 applications were rejected based on their failure to satisfy the eligibility provisions in the Election Regulations or the Constitution of the Association.

This would be considered to be a significant participation rate In light of the Impact that COVID-19 has had on student campus activities.

Distribution and return of ballot papers

Following the closure of the period for the acceptance of postal vote applications, the distribution of ballot papers to electors commenced on the week beginning 16 August 2021. All ballot papers were distributed to electors via registered mail and all successful electors who registered to vote received email correspondence in relation to their postal voting packs being issued via Australia Post.

A decision was made on 31 August 2021 to extend the period for the acceptance of returning ballot papers by seven days due to delays in processing by Australia Post as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The effect of this action was to extend the period for the acceptance of returning ballot papers to Friday 10th September 2021.

Count

After the close of the extended period for the acceptance of returning ballot papers, a count was conducted on Saturday 11 September 2021.

The count was conducted with scrutineers appearing virtually due to the limitations of physical attendance arising from the Victorian Government Health Direction Orders.

More information on the count can be found in the appendices.

Conduct of participants

Throughout the 2021 Annual Election, the conduct of participants was generally good. One dispute was received and upheld in relation to authorisation requirements. Notwithstanding this, the overall conduct of participants in the election were without fault.

Recommendations

This section enables me to raise matters that were of Interest during the 2021 SSU election period. It Is acknowledged that the current Election Regulations are premised on attendance elections and are not primarily designed for non-attendance voting.

Introduction of an Electoral Roll closure period

The Election Regulations of the Association do not currently require a closing date for Swinburne students to become members and therefore nominate for positions within the SSU. Several students joined as SSU members after the Notice of Election was issued and subsequently nominated for positions. Associations typically provide for a closure date to prevent scenarios such as a surge of membership subscriptions linked to a stage of an election. I do note that the voting entitlements of students would not be Impacted by any change to Introduce an electoral roll closure provision based on the current Regulations.

Recommendation

That the Election Regulations be amended to specify a closure date for the Electoral Roll.

Submission of objections

The Election Regulations currently allow for a period of three business days to lodge an objection on any election matter after a Declaration of Poll under Section 92 (b). This Is considered to be quite a significant period of time and does not account for a scenario where a ballot count and Declaration of Poll were to occur on a Saturday or Sunday (as was the case In this election).

This meant that a total of five days were required to elapse after the Declaration of Poll before the election can officially conclude. This creates an unnecessary burden on the Returning Officer and holds up the certification process of the election. It Is reasonable to conclude that any reasonable appeal against a Declaration of Poll Is likely to be lodged within a 24 hour period after the declaration Is made. This would also bring the regulation in alignment with standard practice across student associations In Victoria.

Recommendation

That the Election Regulations be amended to specify that objections to the Declaration of Poll must be received within 24 hours of the date and time of Declaration of Poll by the Returning Officer.

- These elections will be conducted in accordance with the Constitution and Election Regulations of the Swinburne Student Union. Copies of these documents are available from Swinburne Student Union's website – www.ssu.org.au

POSTAL POLLING

Polling will be conducted via postal ballot in accordance with Section 60 (5) of the SSU Constitution due to limited density requirements (maximum number of persons at a particular location) arising from current Victorian State Government health direction orders.

- Postal vote application registration will open from 9.00am Monday 2nd August 2021. The form is available on the SSU website.
- Completed Postal Vote Application Forms must be received by the Returning Officer no later than 5:00pm Friday 13th August 2021.
- Postal polling for all campuses opens on 23rd August 2021 and close at 5:00pm Friday, 3rd September 2021. Completed postal voting packs must be received by the Returning Officer by no later than three business days after close of polling (Friday 3rd September 2021).

TICKETS

- Candidates may choose to organise together under a common banner (ticket). Tickets are for group identification only. Ticket registration forms will be available online at www.ssu.org.au/elections.
- Registration of tickets are open from 9.00am Monday 2nd August 2021 and close on 5.00pm Wednesday 4th August 2021.

ELIGIBILITY AND NOMINATION INFORMATION

- Any student member may nominate for the Swinburne Student Union Inc. council, board and committee positions.
- Each nominee shall require a financial member of the Student Union to nominate them. A nominee may not nominate themselves for election.
- At the time of close of nominations, the nominee must be qualified to vote at the election for which the nominee is a candidate.
- Nominees for all positions except for Media Committee & NUS Delegate must be financial members of the SSU.
- Nominees for the positions of President, Education Officer, Welfare Officer and General Secretary must have been enrolled at Swinburne University of Technology for at least one contiguous Teaching Period within the previous two Teaching Periods.
- No candidate may nominate for or simultaneously hold more than one position per Student Union body. Candidates may nominate and simultaneously hold a position on Council as well as SUPA, SISA, Media Committee or any other committee up for election.
- All other matters pertaining to the Annual Elections are outlined in either this Notice of Election or the SSU Constitution and Regulations.
- Any time stated either in the Notice of Election or a form related to the election is to be assumed to be Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST)
